- Closing date for applications is 26th July 2019
- Students must be of Polish background
- Students must be residents of Victoria
- Students must have permanent Australian residence
- Applicants may be considered for all awards
- Awards may be split between applicants or the amount varied
- The award may be in cash or in kind (goods)
- Awards do not have to be awarded
- New awards may be created
- Applications must be submitted on prescribed forms
- A FULL copy of ALL academic results, from an official transcript, must accompany the application
- Applicants will be required to attend a brief interview
- During the interview an applicant will be asked to present a short (max 10 minutes) PowerPoint presentation on any one subject/question selected by the applicant from the published list "Tematy na interview na temat wiadomości o Polsce" (10/8/19)
- The award selection panel's decision is final
- Only results from the current or previous year can be used (unless otherwise specified)
- Winners details will be published
- Winners MUST attend the awards night otherwise the award may be withdrawn (7 September Punthill Hotel Dandenong)
